Featured entrees include arrabbiata with wok-fired orecchiette, cannelloni saltimbocca stuffed with lamb belly, prosciutto and sage. Always save room for dessert by pastry chef Sara Lamb. Her budino is custardy, salty, sweet and topped with crackling sugar.
